A very useful news consolidation service. If you put into the search bar "fracking", it will present news items related to fracking in a very manageable form making it much easier to keep abreast of what is happening.

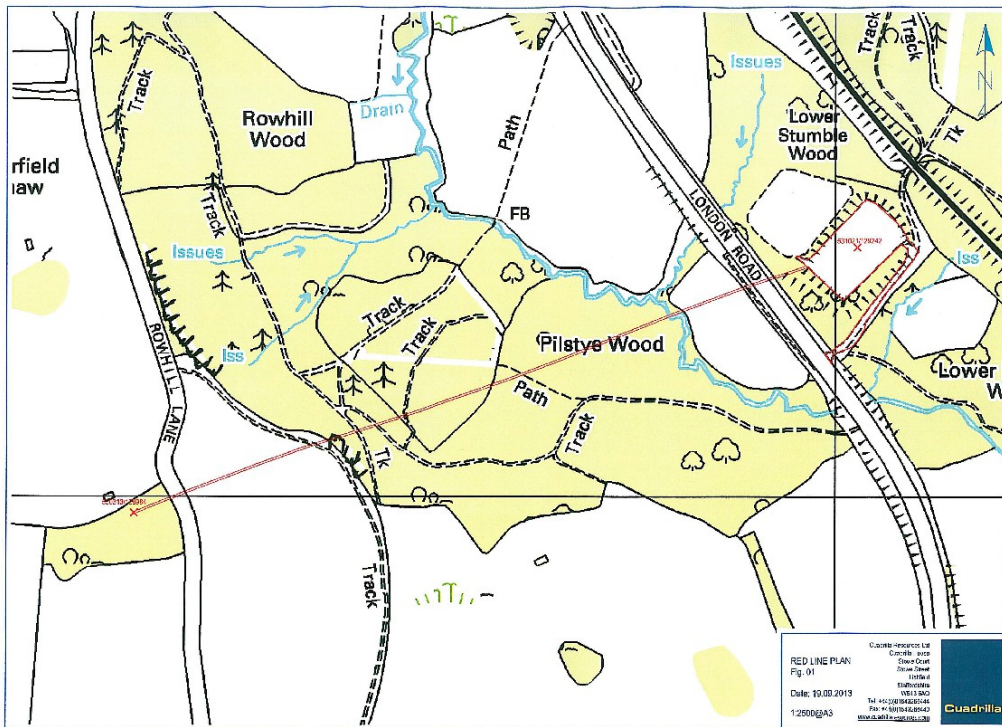

WSCC has recently made available to FFBRA, Cuadrilla's initial planning application to return to Balcombe and continue working at Lower Stumble which they submitted in September 2013.

Since FFBRA has not yet seen the finalised application which is expected to be made public in January 2014, no information from this application has been included in this newsletter other than the map below showing where they drilled earlier this year.

Cuadrilla has drilled horizontally from the Lower Stumble site under Pilstye Wood to just beyond Rowhill Lane. This is indicated by a red line on the map below.
